

Know What To Look For... Know What To Report

Terrorist and other criminals can't be identified by appearance or nationality. We can only identify them by observing suspicious activity that may lead us to a criminal act.

Some suspicious activities you should report to MSAIC include:

- Unusual interest in public utilities, transportation centers, government buildings
- Unusual requests for information
- Fraudulent/conflicting documents
- Unusual purchases, deliveries or thefts of poisonous or flammable chemicals, weapons, or public service uniforms (police, mail carrier, public utilities etc)
- Surveillance (monitoring activities, videotaping, etc) particularly of a high risk or symbolic target
- Individuals who appear to engage in tests of security procedures or "dry runs" of potential attacks

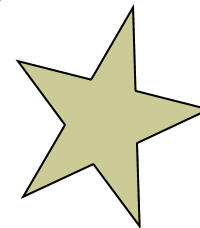

- ⇒ Date of Suspicious Activity
- ⇒ Location of Activity
- ⇒ Names of Individuals
- ⇒ Vehicle Registration/Description
- ⇒ Brief Narrative of the Activity
- ⇒ Your Name
- ⇒ Your Contact Information
